

How You Get Your Financial Aid Disbursement & Refund

1. For all funding sources (grants, student loans, scholarships), a student's annual financial aid eligibility is determined by the Financial Aid Office.

2. Financial aid funds for a given term are disbursed into the student's Cal Poly student account at the beginning of each term, or as they become available thereafter.

Disbursed financial aid funds will generally be applied against registration fees and housing charges, if any. *All charges not covered by financial aid must be paid by the student before they can register for their next term. Students are advised to view their account activity at least once a week.*

3. Once the charges have been paid, leftover financial aid funds are refunded to the student.

Parent PLUS loan refund checks are mailed to the parent unless the parent submits a signed Authorization Form permitting the PLUS refund to be released to the student.

The Cal Poly refund process runs twice each week.

Financial aid funds will NOT be disbursed to the student's Cal Poly student account until the student has enrolled in the required number of units (for financial aid funding purposes, wait listed classes are not included in the unit count).

The FASTEST most SECURE way for a student to receive a financial aid refund is through the Direct Deposit process.

Signing up for Direct Deposit allows Cal Poly to transmit the financial aid refund directly into the student's bank account of choice. Cal Poly then sends the student a courtesy email informing them of the transfer. It's that simple!

Sign up for Direct Deposit NOW:

Portal - Money Matters tab - Student Center link (under the Student Accounts & Payment Info column) - scroll down to the Finance section - click on the DIRECT DEPOSIT link (please remember to save your entries).

Mailing your refund check: if you don't sign up for Direct Deposit, your refund check will be sent to your mailing address. We cannot guarantee a delivery time, and if the check is lost - for any reason - the student cannot be issued a new check until the State's Stop Payment process has been completed. **Avoid delays...go with Direct Deposit!**
